LENDING STRATEGY

The GTF product provides term loans to Irish SMEs and small mid-cap companies across a range of sectors. BVP partners with ambitious Irish businesses, using growth capital to support expansion, operational development, and long-term value creation.

THE FACILITY

The BVP GTF facility provides term loans of €500,000 to €5,000,000 to eligible Irish SMEs and small mid-caps, for terms of up to 8 years.

The facility benefits from funding support by the Strategic Banking Corporation of Ireland (SBCI).

Loans are subject to SBCI and EIF Sustainability Guarantee eligibility criteria.

Who is Our Debt Facility For?

Many businesses assume GTF is only for cleantech or renewable energy companies - it isn't. Eligibility is assessed based on the nature of the investment, and a wide range of mainstream businesses qualify.

Route 1 - Your Business Already Operates Sustainably

- ✓ Holds an environmental certification (e.g. ISO 14001) or recognised eco-label
- ✓ Derives 90%+ of revenue from a specified green or sustainable activity
- ✓ Has reduced energy, water or GHG emissions by 20%+ per unit of output over the past 5 years
- ✓ Awarded a cleantech or green prize or grant from an EU/national body within the last 3 years
- ✓ Holds a registered clean energy or climate-related IP right

Route 2 - Your Investment Improves Sustainability

-  Manufacturing & facility upgrades - equipment or automation that reduces waste, energy or water usage
-  Growth & Expansion - working capital to support development
-  Renewable energy - solar, wind, heat pumps, energy storage, on-site generation
-  Circular economy - recycling, waste reduction, sustainable materials
-  Sustainable building - commercial retrofits improving energy certification

A traditional manufacturer investing in new machinery that cuts energy consumption per unit, reduces material waste, or lowers water usage can qualify - even if the business doesn't operate within the "green" sector

Precision Engineering & Metal Fabrication

New automated laser cutting or machining equipment

→ reduced waste and energy per unit



Medical Device Manufacturing

HVAC, cleanroom, or sterilisation upgrades

→ lower energy consumption per cycle

Pasteurisation, refrigeration, or packaging automation upgrades

→ reduced electricity and product waste

→ proven 20% reduction in energy consumption
